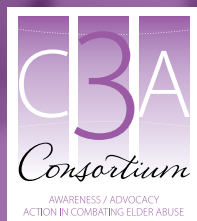
**Conference Summary:** Understanding and responding to the cumulative effects and impact of earlier life trauma is important when interacting with older adults who often face new traumas or stressors, including elder abuse. This conference will explore the influence of early life trauma experiences and how these incidences may influence the emotions, behaviors and health of older adults. Trauma-informed practices emphasize physical, psychological and emotional safety for both consumers and providers, and helps survivors rebuild a sense of control and empowerment.
